You're invited to join the Weekly Writing Group!

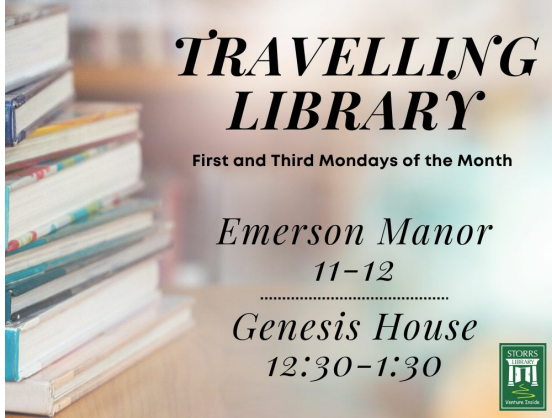

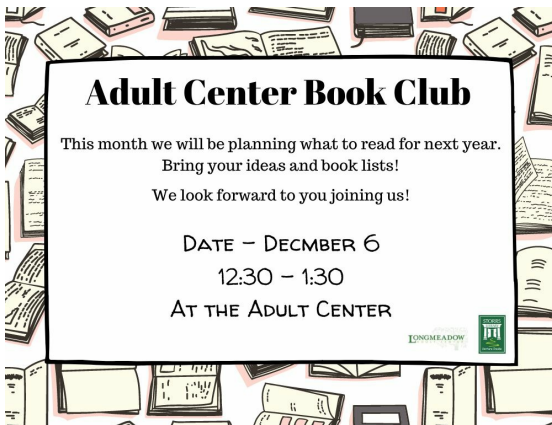
On the first and third Monday of the month residents of Emerson Manor and Genesis House can swing by the courtyard next to
