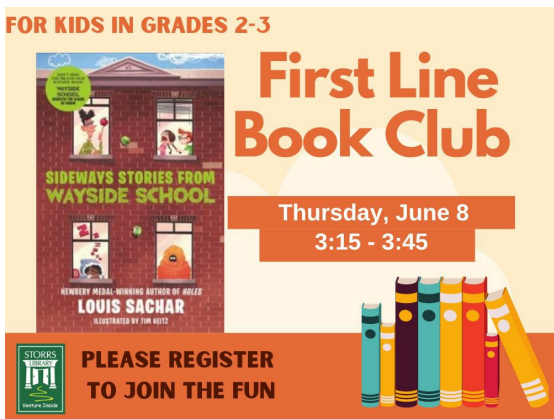
Wednesday, June 7, 8:00–10:00

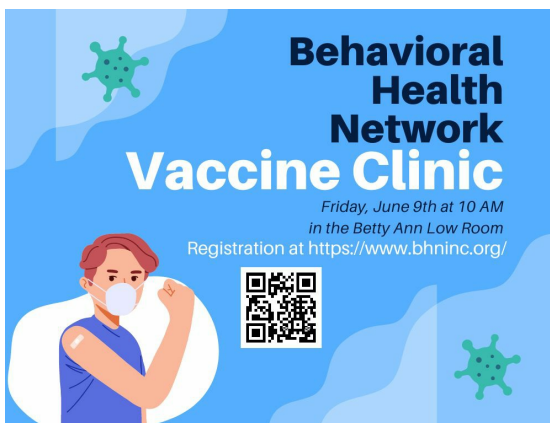
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BHN Vaccine Clinic
