Community Donation Drive

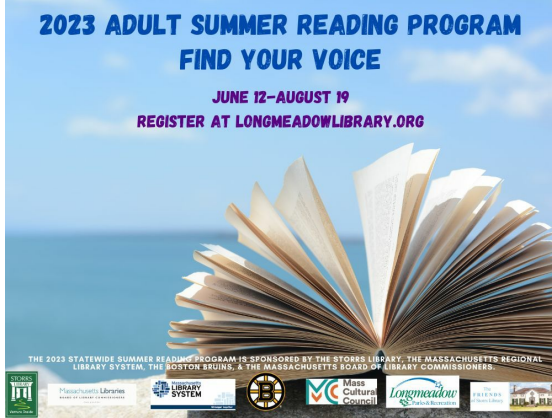

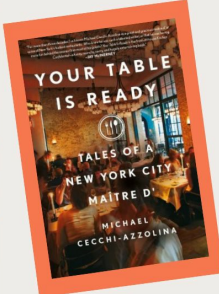

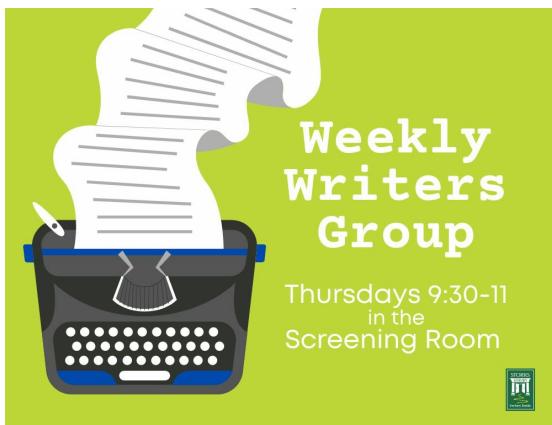

Thursday, June 15, 9:30-11:00



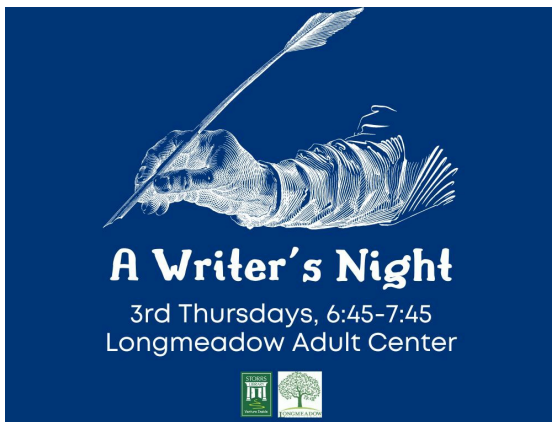
You're invited to join the Weekly Writing Group!
