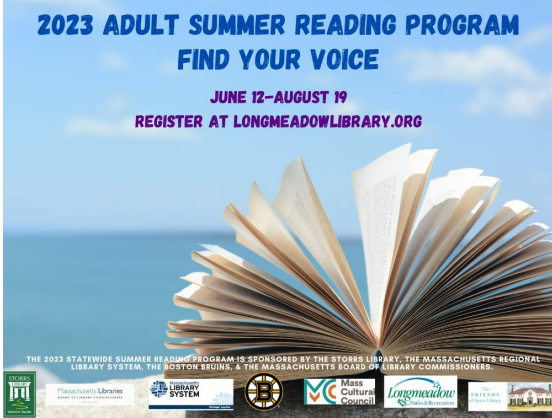
DONATIONS WILL BE COLLECTED IN THE FRONT LOBBY OF STORRS LIBRARY

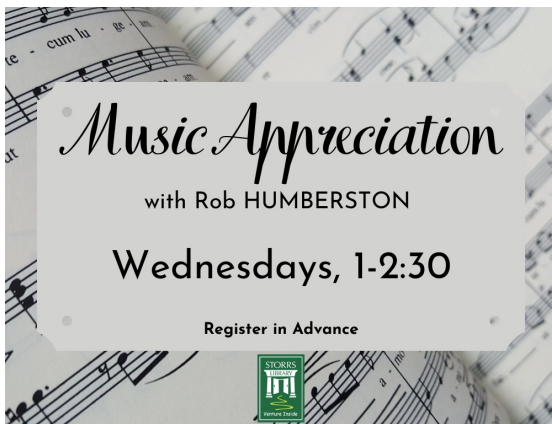
