Community Donation Drive

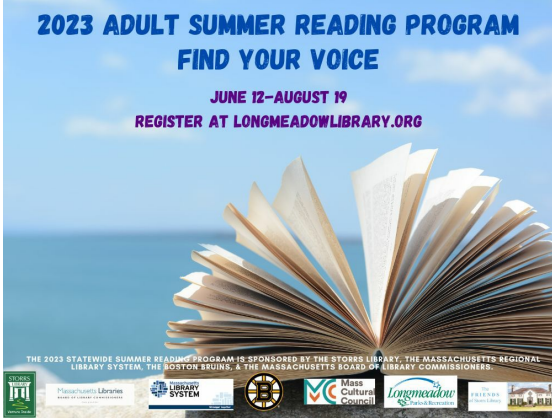

Tuesday, July 11, 9:00–12:00



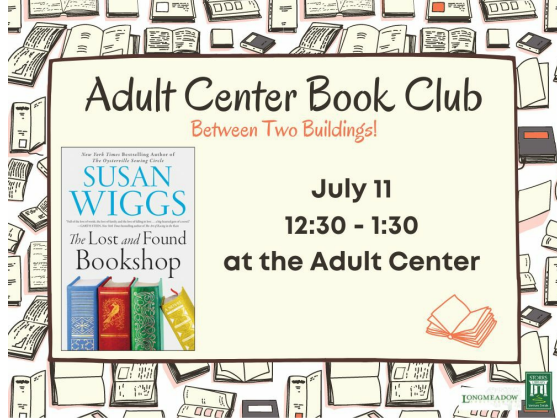
