Monday, November 27 – Saturday, December 9



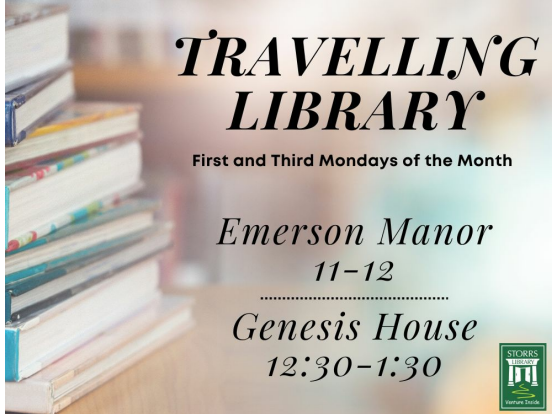

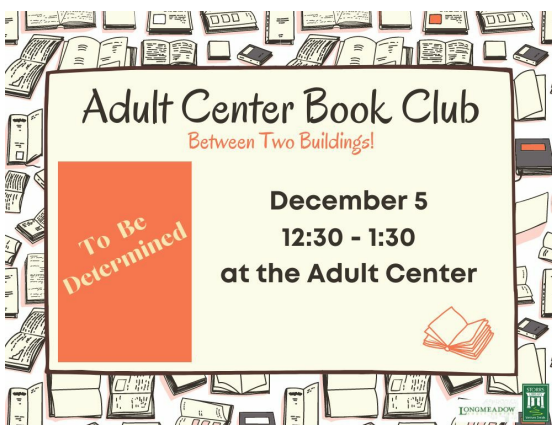

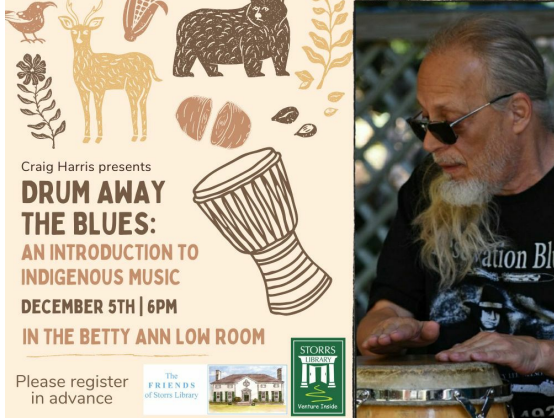
