## Process Art (ages 3-6yrs) Monday, December 11, 10:00-10:45




#### Read More/Register


# Tot Time (ages 2-3yrs) Tuesday, December 12, 9:30-10:00


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## First Line Book Club (gr. 2–3)

## Grow Play Learn (birth-5yrs) Wednesday, December 13, 9:30-10:30






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## Let's Laugh Book Club (gr. 4-5)
